Key Responsibilities/ Essential Functions of the Position:

- Develop a strong understanding of the DTI QMS and Safety programs.
- Perform reviews of Material Certs to ensure compliance with Engineering requirements.
- Conduct Quality Control measures involving visual and dimensional inspections of raw material, work-in-progress, and finished products using gauges, calipers, and micrometers, as well as additional inspection & measuring equipment to ensure that applicable procedures are within compliance and product components are inspected to verify conformance.
- Responsible for Control of Calibrated equipment requirements and ensuring all equipment requiring calibration is kept under control.
- Review and interpret blueprints, engineering documents, and quality manuals to ensure product(s) meet specifications.
- Plan, execute, and oversee product inspection and testing for quality and conformance to specifications and deliverables.
- Report nonconformances found during receipt inspection processes and ensure disposition is carried out.
- Maintain detailed, accurate, and up-to-date records of quality control and inventory inspections along with various metrics such as the number of defective products found.
- Generate reports from data collected during quality control inspections to highlight issues, detail the number of defective products being produced, and explain where improvements can be made.
- Assist with and document investigations of field failures and ensure corrective action is implemented and effective.
- Ensure all documentation related to inventory flow is complete, accurate and filed correctly.
- Identify and report on any gaps in inventory & ensure accuracy of inventory levels.
- Perform cycle counts and assessment of stock condition.
- Other duties as assigned by the Quality Director, Operations Manager, Asset/Inventory Manager.
